State Tournament Roster Rules

1. Rosters **MUST** be complete, front and back.
 - A. Players cannot be added to Roster after July 1 of Current Year.
 - B. A player may sign roster at the tournament site if his name is already on the roster.
2. Roster **MUST** be at State Tournament Site prior to tournament.
3. **NO ROSTER, NO PLAY**
4. A team **WILL NOT** be allowed to fill out a roster at the State Tournament Site.
5. Player will be required to sign in prior to playing in any game.
 - A. Players will be required to show picture ID (Drivers License) when signing in.
 - B. Any team that has a player that has played or is playing and has not signed in will forfeit the game.
6. Each State Tournament Site will have an AASA Rep. and an AASA UIC on site.
7. **Alabama ASA Pick Up Player Rule:** After a player has played in the District Tournament (1st Level of Championship Play) he/she can be a Pick Up Player on another team as long as their original team does not advance to the State Tournament. An Alabama ASA Pick Up Player Form **MUST** be completed for the player to be legal and **MUST** be completed prior to July 1 of the current year. A team may only pick up a maximum of two (2) players prior to the State Tournament. The player(s) being picked up **MUST** have participated in the District Tournament, **not just listed on a roster**. All pick up players must meet all ASA Classification Guidelines.
8. **Alabama Add on Player Rule:** A team may add one (1) player to the roster prior to July 1 if that player has not been on an ASA Roster during the current year. The player must meet all ASA Classification Guidelines for the classification in which they will be playing. An Alabama ASA Add on Player Form **MUST** be completed for the player to be legal.

ASA Pick Up Player Rules

1. A Team that has met all State criteria to go to a National Tournament may pick up three (3) players to compete with them at the National Tournament. However, roster limit of 20, to include pick ups, **MUST** be adhered to.
2. The pick up player must have been on an ASA roster in the current season/year.
3. The pick up player must come from the same Division of play or lower.
4. The pick up player must be placed on an ASA Pick Up Player Form.
5. Pick up player form **MUST** be signed by State Commissioner or Adult Division Director.
